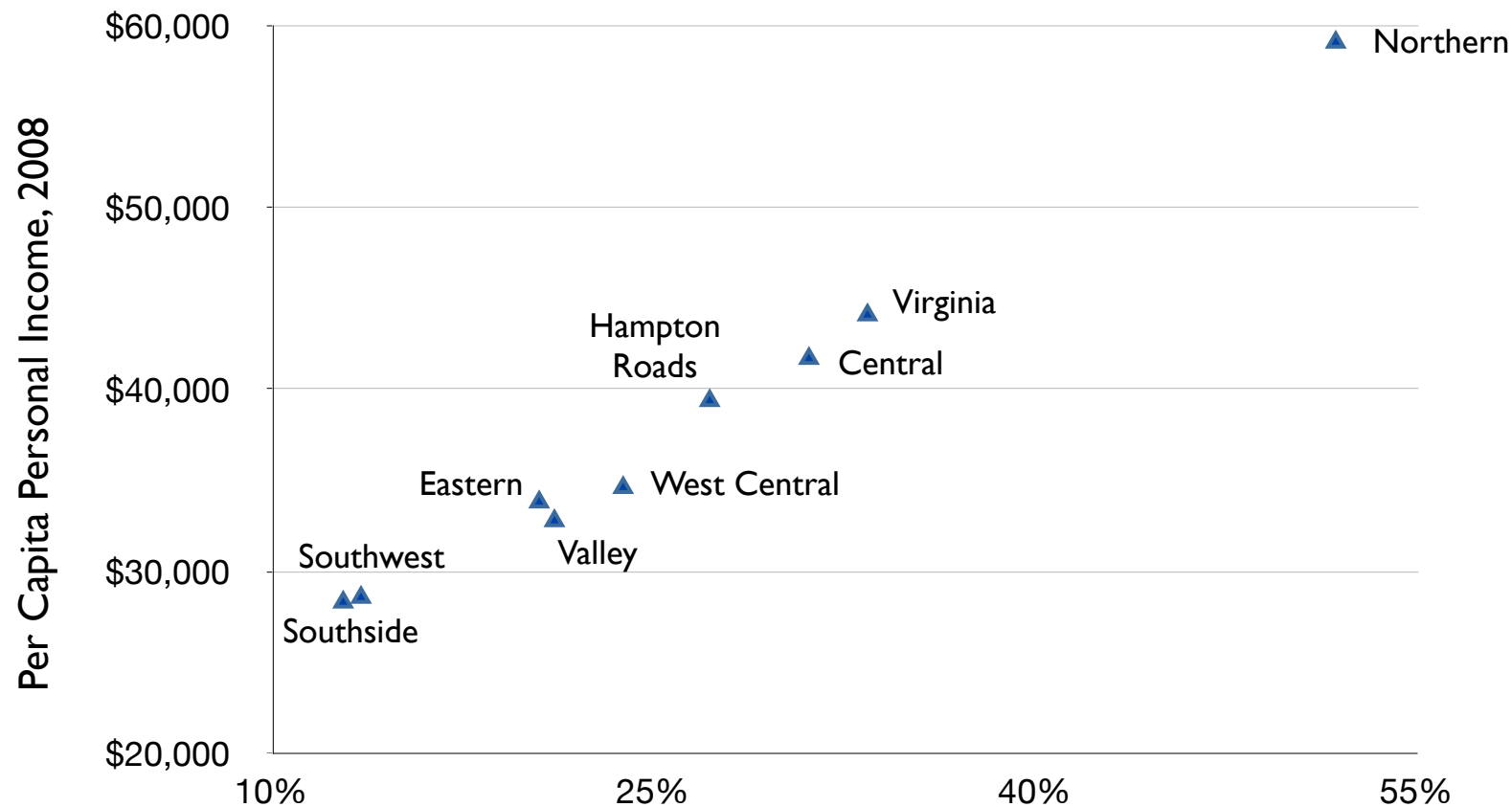

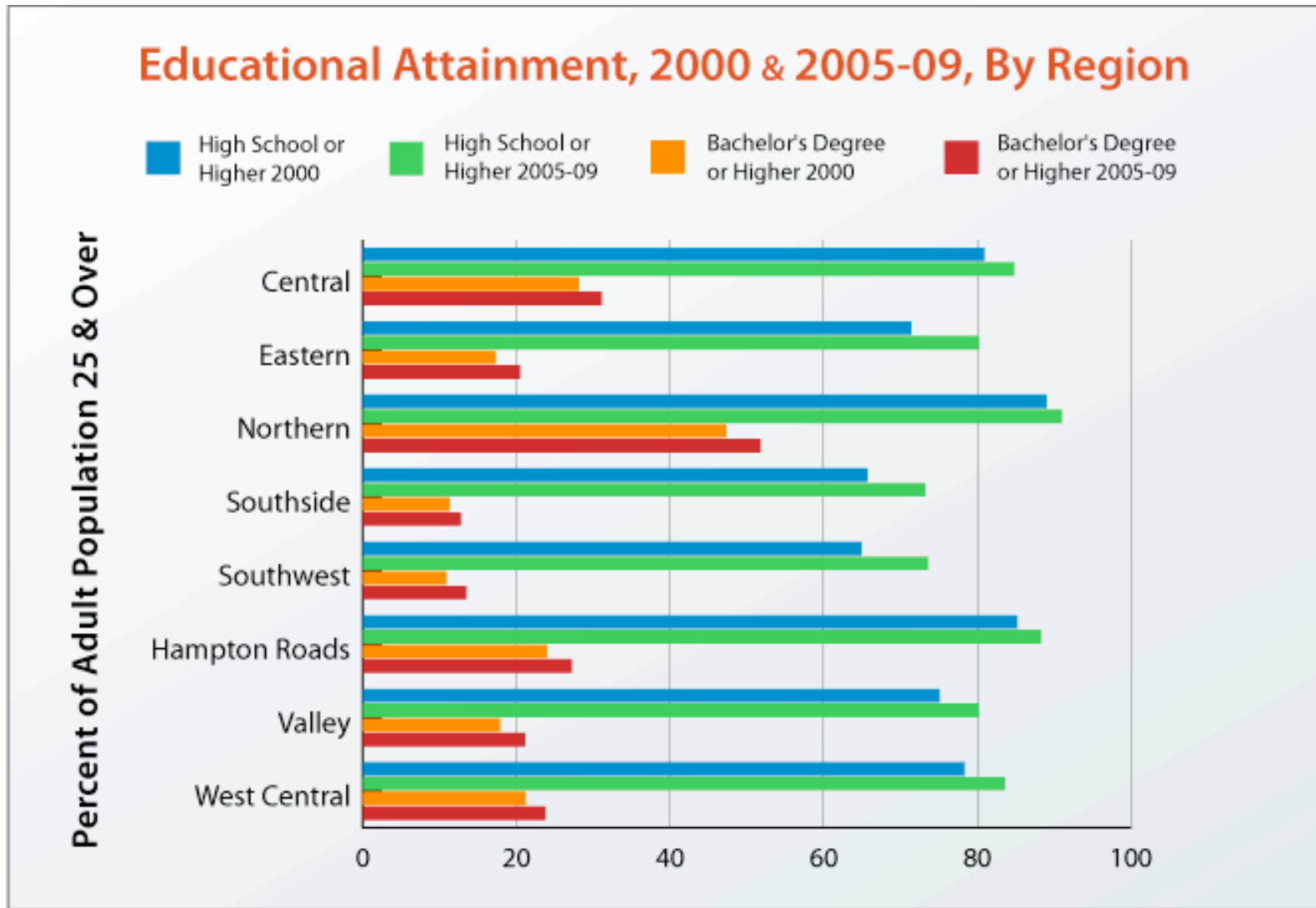
Per Capita Personal Income and Educational Attainment: Virginia's Regions



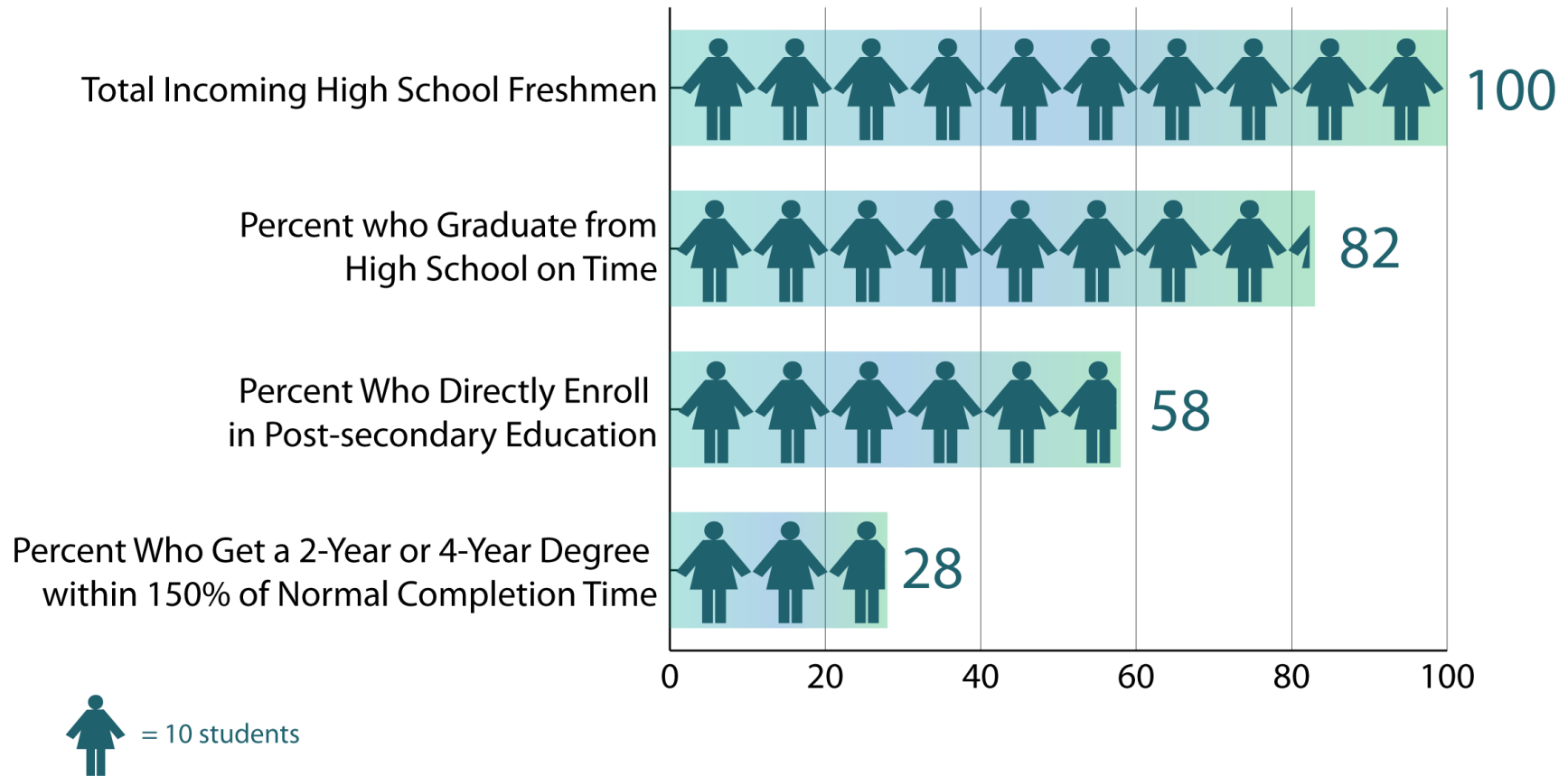
Percent of the Population 25 and Over with at Least a Bachelor's Degree, 2005-2009

Educational Attainment is Improving Across the State, but Significant Regional Differences Remain

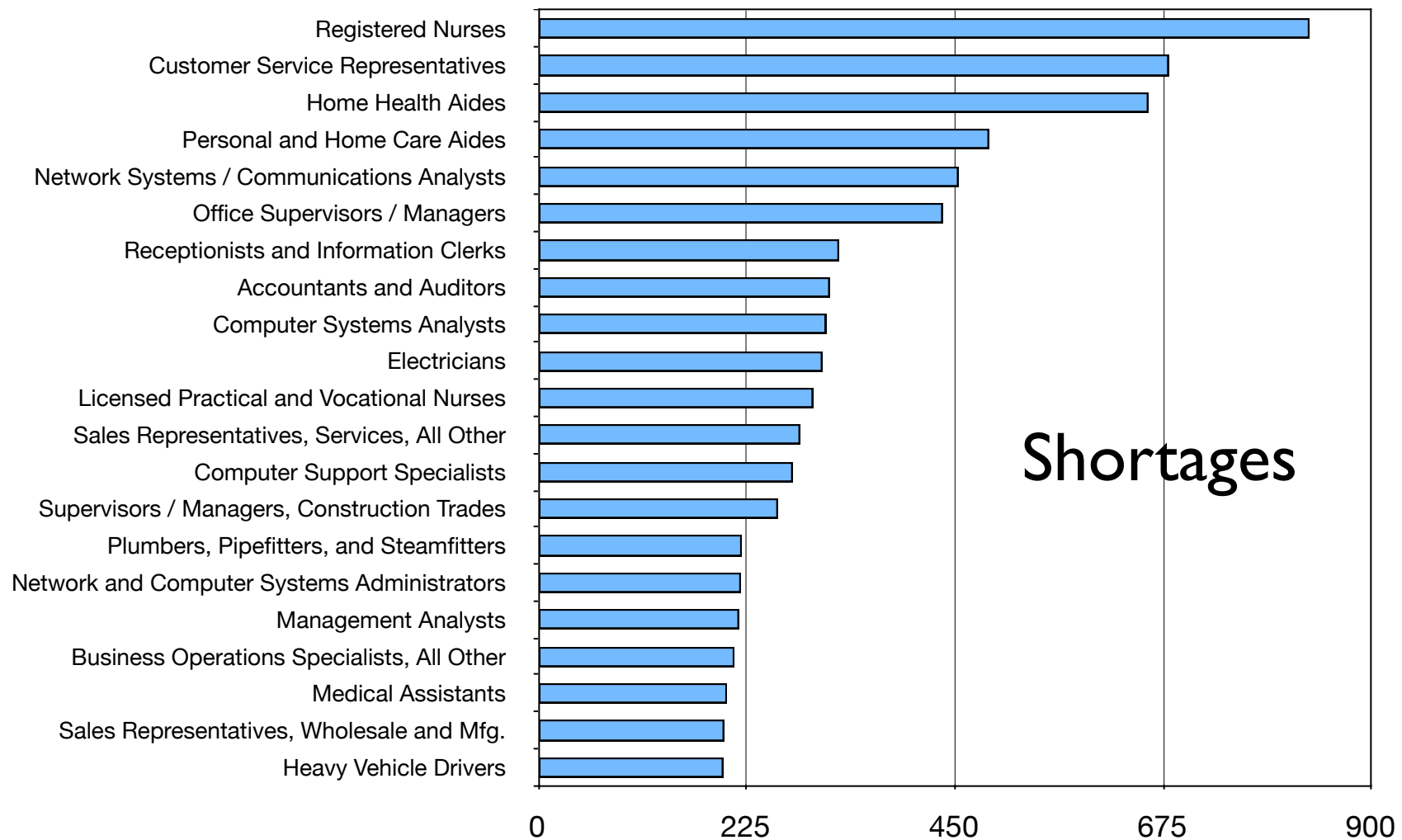


Educational Attrition Rates in Virginia (2008)



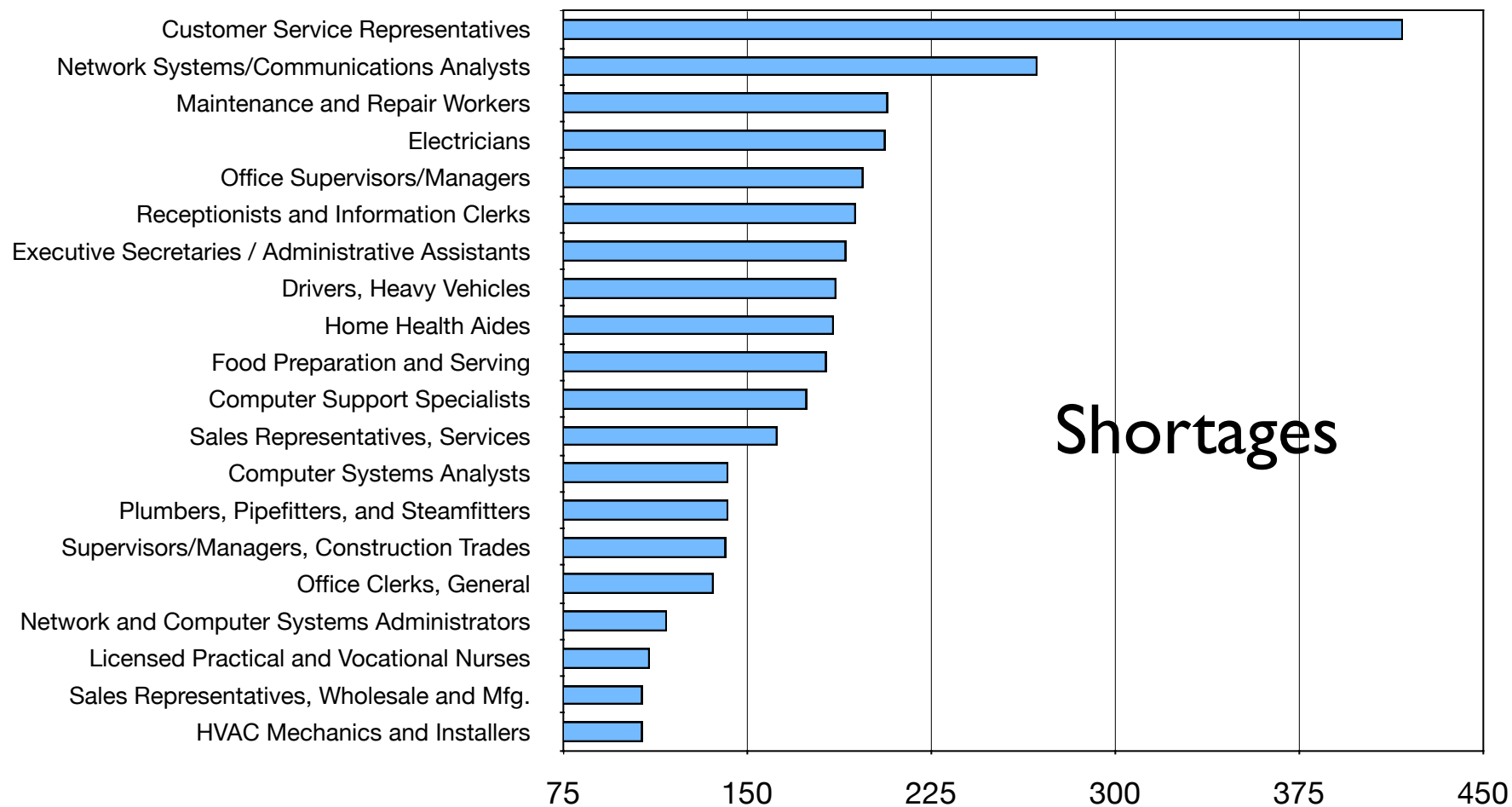

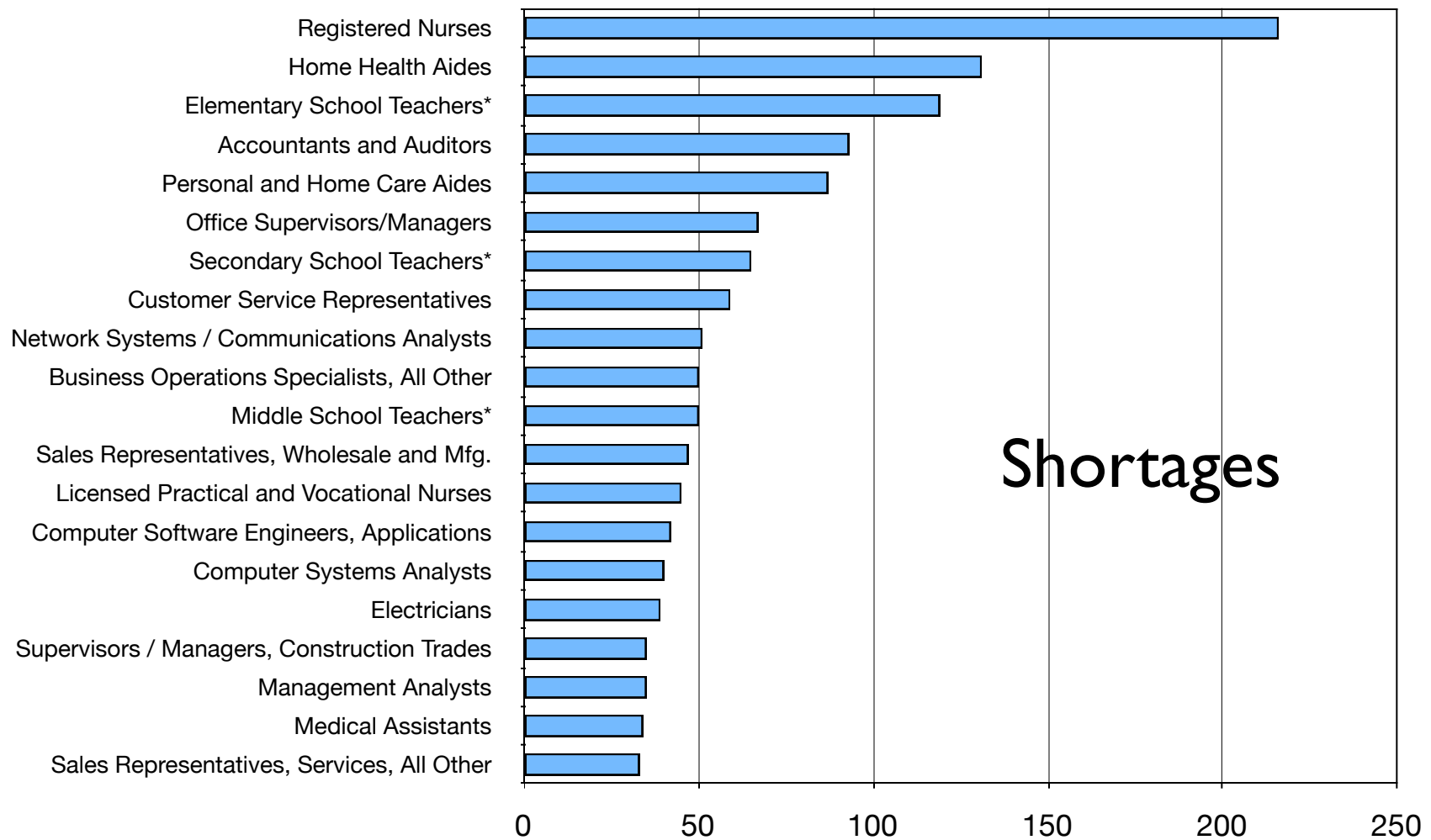
Twenty Largest Annual Occupational Supply Gap, Northern Virginia MSA, 2011
