

Driving Directions to the Central Grounds Parking Garage at the University of Virginia

From I-64:

Following signs to the UVA Information Center, get off at exit 118B (Route 29/250 Bypass)
Go approximately 2 miles on bypass and take the off ramp for Route 250 East Business (Ivy Road)
Turn right off the exit ramp and follow Ivy Road
At the fourth traffic light, turn right onto Route 29 Business/Emmet Street
Take the third left into the University of Virginia Central Grounds parking garage
In garage, take elevator to fourth floor – walk across brick terrace towards Newcomb Hall (located directly behind garage)

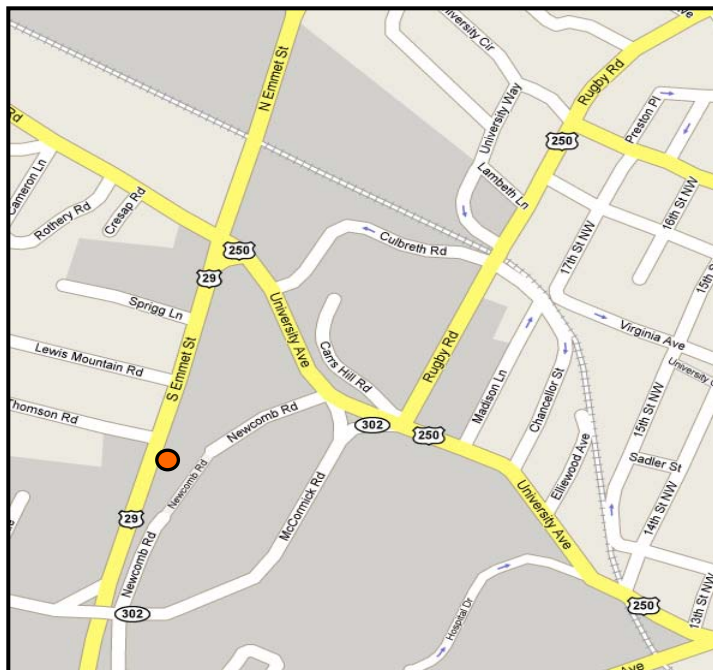
Traveling North to Charlottesville:

Follow Route 29 North
Take the off ramp for Route 250 East Business (Ivy Road)
Turn right off the exit ramp and follow Ivy Road
At the fourth traffic light, turn right on Route 29 Business/Emmet Street
Take the third left into the University of Virginia Central Grounds parking garage
In garage, take elevator to fourth floor – walk across brick terrace towards Newcomb Hall (located directly behind garage)

Traveling South to Charlottesville:

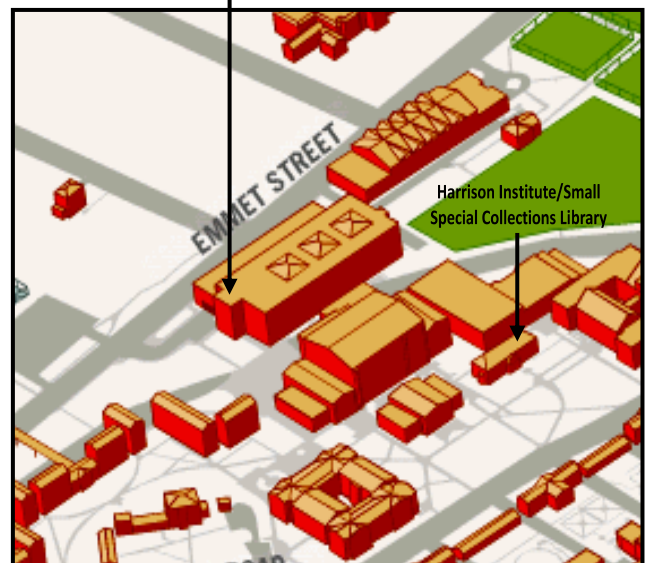
From Gainesville, follow Route 29 South to Charlottesville
In Charlottesville, keep straight on Rt. 29 Business to U.Va. (Route 29 Business will become Emmet Street)
Follow Emmet Street past Barracks Road Shopping Center and University Hall (basketball arena) which will be on the right
Proceed straight through the next traffic light at the intersection of Emmet Street and University Avenue/Ivy Road
Take the third left into the University of Virginia Central Grounds parking garage
In garage, take elevator to fourth floor – walk across brick terrace towards Newcomb Hall (located directly behind garage)

Walking Directions from the Central Grounds Parking Garage to the Harrison Institute/Small Special Collections Library at the University of Virginia



Harrison Institute/Small Special Collections Library is centrally located on University Grounds, located off of McCormick Road to the West of the University Lawn and Jefferson's Academical Village.

From the top floor of the Central Grounds Parking garage, walk across the brick courtyard and follow the steps around the right side of Newcomb Hall. Walk through the courtyard taking a left as you pass Peabody Hall. Continue across the courtyard to the main entrance of the Special Collections Library.

The auditorium is located on the lower level (just to your left as you get to the bottom of the stairs).
